

Patient Authorization (eP)

To proceed with the issuance of an Electronic Prescription (ePrescription), as a physician you must first ensure that you are interacting directly with the patient and not a third party.

Once logged into the system, follow the steps below:

1. Patient Identification or Registration

During the initial entry of the Electronic Prescription (ePrescription), you must enter the patient's demographic details as well as their phone number. Alternatively, you may search for the patient using their ID Card Number (AΔT) or ARC number and date of birth.

2. Patient Authorization via OTP

The National Electronic Health System (ESE) sends a unique One-Time Password (OTP) to the patient, which the patient provides to you. You then enter the OTP into the system. This OTP serves as valid consent from the patient, granting you access to their medical data for healthcare purposes.
